



MARRIAGE CERTIFICATES

(All relevant documents must be completed using BLACK INK PEN)

REQUIREMENTS FOR A COPY OF A MARRIAGE CERTIFICATE (MARRIAGE ALREADY REGISTERED IN RSA)

Any person may apply for a copy of a Marriage Certificate provided that the marriage has been registered with the South African Government. The person who is making the application must state clearly the reason for application.

If you have a previous certificate, please attach a certified copy so that it becomes easier to trace the record.

ALL APPLICATION FORMS ARE OBTAINABLE AT THE CONSULATE

The following documentation is required for a copy of a Marriage Certificate (marriage already registered in RSA):

- Fully completed form BI-130 in black ink
- Copy of passport and/or ID document
- Copy of temporary/permanent residence
- Copy of previous certificate, if possible
- Payment of the prescribed fee (please see Tariffs).

PLEASE NOTE:

- ❖ It is strongly recommended to apply for an Unabridged Apostilled Certificate. There is no additional cost.
- ❖ All payments are in cash only and the correct amount must be provided.
- ❖ Applications are likely to take 20 to 30 weeks and possibly longer.
